Birding Tour

The "Behind the Gates" birding tour for up to 4 people, is an opportunity to tour lesser-seen parts of the Sauvie Island Wildlife Area with Manager and life-long birder Mark Nebeker. Get ready to take flight at 8am for this exciting ~5 hour tour, beginning with Oak Island and the Eastside Units of the Wildlife Area.

Falconry Trip

At least 5,000 years old, falconry is one of the oldest hunting arts still practiced today. This experience is for 4 people to join 2 licensed Oregon Master falconers in the field for a full day of ultimate bird-watching, as the hawks and falcons pursue wild quarry.

Kayak Tour

This 4 hour tour for up to 6 people, starts at the Scappoose Bay marina, crossing the channel and then sneaking into the Cunningham Slough. On this tour you will spy on herons and raptors as you move through flooded stands of cottonwood trees, search for beaver dens and song birds, and marvel at the unique ecosystem of the Lower Columbia Flood Plain. This serene paddling location is only open to public for a few months of the year so don't miss out!
